Welthungerhilfe Elects a new Supervisory Board: Marlehn Thieme Confirmed as President

Berlin, 2020-11-26 The General Assembly of Welthungerhilfe has elected a new honorary Supervisory Board. Marlehn Thieme was confirmed once again as President, and Prof. Joachim von Braun, Director at the Center for Development Research (ZEF) at the University of Bonn was confirmed as Vice-President.

"The effects of the COVID-19 pandemic pose new challenges for our work and our staff worldwide. Welthungerhilfe has shown over recent months that it is well prepared to reduce hunger and poverty around the world, and to improve many people's lives", says Marlehn Thieme.

Rita Lanius-Heck and Dr Tobias Schulz-Isenbeck left the Supervisory Board, and were thanked for their many years of service. Lanius-Heck represented the Rural Women's Association, which has been financing concrete projects to support women in rural areas for many years. Schulz-Isenbeck diligently applied his expertise in the area of marketing and finance on the Supervisory Board for 16 years.
